



GUIDELINES OF CIVILITY FOR TOURISTS AND VISITORS TO EUSKADI

- ✦ **The Natural and Cultural Heritage belongs to all peoples**, enjoy it, preserve its universal values and avoid negative impacts that affect its survival.
- ✦ **Do not introduce invasive species or acquire protected flora and fauna or products derived from these species.** Do not remove any material from geological formations of interest either.
- ✦ **Avoid making noise in the areas of greatest natural and cultural value** and do not introduce acoustic distortion.
- ✦ **Do not make any fires**, except in areas equipped for this purpose, **or throw cigarette butts on the ground** as they could cause fires that are difficult to put out especially in wooded areas and mountainous areas.
- ✦ **Do not use more water and energy than necessary and throw your waste away responsibly** not leaving any litter as you go, using the selective separation containers.
- ✦ **Travel by car or motorbike as little as possible.** Organise travelling on foot, bicycle or public transport whenever you can.
- ✦ **Choose responsible tourist establishments** that take into account recycling, energy and water savings and respect for the local community and natural and cultural heritage.
- ✦ **If you have the occasion, consume local products**, as added to enjoying local cuisine, culture and crafts you will be contributing to the conservation and sustainable development of the environment.
- ✦ **Treat people with respect**, preserving their dignity, treating them as equals.
- ✦ **Spread the word about the beauty and interest of the environment you visit**, helping responsible tourism in the area to contribute to its maintenance over time.
