



GUIDELINES OF CIVILITY FOR TOURISTS AND VISITORS TO EUSKADI

- **The Natural and Cultural Heritage belongs to all peoples**, enjoy it, preserve its universal values and avoid negative impacts that affect its survival.
- Monot introduce invasive species or acquire protected flora and fauna or products derived from these species. Do not remove any material from geological formations of interest either.
- X Avoid making noise in the areas of greatest natural and cultural value and do not introduce acoustic distortion.
- Monot make any fires, except in areas equipped for this purpose, or throw cigarette butts on the ground as they could cause fires that are difficult to put out especially in wooded areas and mountainous areas.
- X Do not use more water and energy than necessary and throw your waste away responsibly not leaving any litter as you go, using the selective separation containers.
- **Travel by car or motorbike as little as possible.** Organise travelling on foot, bicycle or public transport whenever you can.
- **Choose responsible tourist establishments** that take into account recycling, energy and water savings and respect for the local community and natural and cultural heritage.
- **If you have the occasion, consume local products,** as added to enjoying local cuisine, culture and crafts you will be contributing to the conservation and sustainable development of the environment.
- **Treat people with respect,** preserving their dignity, treating them as equals.
- Spread the word about the beauty and interest of the environment you visit, helping responsible tourism in the area to contribute to its maintenance over time.
